



How do I use the left hand menu to access the Free Beanie doll clothes pattern and videos?

1. After Logging In you will see an empty menu for the “How to Sew Doll Clothes Course”, “Free Bonus Patterns” and “Doll Clothes Patterns” (assuming you have not purchased these products). Below this you will see the menu “Free Patterns”. This menu contains your Free Pattern.



2. Click once on “Free Patterns” menu and the Free Beanie menu will appear below it. Click once on the “Free Beanie” menu and the “Free Beanie - Steps to Complete Your Outfit” will appear below it. When you click on the Steps to Complete Your Outfit, everything you need to get started is on the page that opens to the right of the menu as outlined over the page.





3. As with all my Patterns you will be taken to the “Steps to Complete Your Outfit” page. This page contains a link to both your PDF Pattern Pieces and PDF Patterns Instructions. Just click on these and they will open in another window and you can print and download and save these PDF documents to your computer forever. Below these two links are a series of numbered links. Simply click on these and they will take you to each video which shows you step by step how to make your outfit.

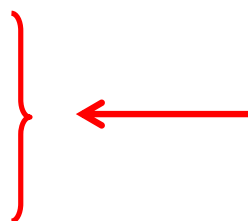
